9 days safari in Kenya

This is referred to as Kenya safari the best because it takes you to the Northern Side of the country's National Game reserves. There you can find different kinds of animals from the rest of National parks. It also shows you the richest areas in agricultural products with a chance of visiting a historical place like Tree Tops and also takes you to the biggest Flamingo lake Nakuru. It goes further and takes you to the 7th wonder of the world which is Maasai Mara National reserve. There is also much more to enjoy whilst on this tour for both family and friends you are all Welcome!



Day 1 – Welcome to Nairobi

You are met on arrival and where you will be transferred to your city hotel. Depending on the time of arrival after check in, the rest of the will be optional. You may choose to go on a city tour in Nairobi, the city popularly known as “the Green city in the sun”.

Accommodation: city hotel

Meals: breakfast.

Day 2 - Samburu

After breakfast at 7:30 am, you will join your safari driver and drive the Northern side through Equator up to Samburu Game Reserve, arriving good time for lunch. At 1600hrs afternoon Game Drive. Samburu is homeland to the nomadic and colourful Samburu people. The region is also a popular stop for the Game watchers. Home to unique local species like Gravy Zebra, Somali Ostrich, Oryx and its also famous for Leopard. The river Game includes Crocodile, Hippo as well as the usual plain wildlife. Dinner and overnight in Samburu Game Lodge

Accommodation: Samburu lodge

Meals: full board

Day 3 - Samburu

A full day is spent in this game reserve doing morning and afternoon game drive. You can visit a Maasai village as an optional decision. Dinner and overnight in the reserve Game Lodge

Day 4 – Aberdare National park

After breakfast we drive back through Equator to the Outspan Hotel in Nyeri for Lunch. Overnight will be at Tree Tops Lodge. From Outspan the hotel transport takes you to the Tree Tops Lodge. Only overnight bag is required and the rest of the bags will be stored at the Outspan Hotel. Warm cloths are required for overnight. Outspan is the reception to Tree Tops and it was once the house of Lord BADEN POWELL who was the founder of the scout movement in the country. His graveyard is within this area where you may pay a visit. At Tree Tops you have a chance to view wildlife coming down to the water hole for watering.

Day 5 – Lake Nakuru

Morning tea/coffee, joined by Hotel transport back to Outspan Hotel for your English breakfast. After breakfast join your Safari driver and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park with a stop on the way at Thomson Falls. Arriving at Lake Nakuru in time for lunch. Check in at your hotel and lunch in the hotel followed by an afternoon Game Drive. Lake Nakuru is a salt water lake and the home of thousand and thousands of great & lesser flamingos also a place of wide range animals including Lions, Leopards, Giraffes, Buffalos, and white Rhino only notable exceptions being the Elephant. The park is also a bird paradise with over 400 known species spotted in the park. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Accommodation: Bontana Hotel

Meals: full board

Day 6 – Maasai Mara

Depart from Nakuru after breakfast and proceed to Maasai Mara Game Reserve.

Masai Mara national reserve offers an absolutely unique variety of animals. The reason is that this hilly region is both humid and fertile, and is crossed by rivers Mara and Talek, full of crocodiles and hippos and which carry water the year whole round. The banks of the rivers are covered in thick forest which gradually makes way for bush and grassland. The abundance of water and excellent availability of food are reasons why Masai Mara which infact is the continuation of the Tanzanian Serengeti National Park has the greatest population of wild animals in the whole Africa. There is a particularly a dramatic spectacle from July to November, the annual migration of huge herds of gnus and zebras. These herds are, of course, closely followed by predators such as hyenas, jackals, leopards and lions. There is no place where more of these latter may be seen than Masai Mara. Gigantic herds of over 200 buffalos can also be observed. Plenty of food is available for elephants, giraffes and the many species of antelopes and gazelles all of which can be observed in their natural habitat.

Day 7 – Maasai Mara

Full day with morning and afternoon Game drive in this national game reserve

Day 8 – Maasai Mara

This day you may decide to do hot air balloon safari and have an experience that you will never forget. In the morning you join balloon crew, who will take you to the takeoff point and enjoy wonderful events and good sunrise photos. You then come down to have your breakfast in the wild together with carnivores with wonderful smile. After breakfast, you have a short game viewing, with balloons cruisers taking you back to the lodge for relaxation till lunch. After lunch, you may decide to leave early for a Maasai village followed by game viewing in the park. Returning back to your lodge for dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: Keekerok Lodge.

Meals: full board

Day 9 - Nairobi

Breakfasts is followed by check out then proceed and drive back to Nairobi arriving lunchtime.
