



FLAMINGO SAFARI - GOLF PACKAGE PROGRAMME



This tour includes four different Golf Courses, as well as two separate National Parks. These places are extremely beautiful and particularly satisfying for Golfers. We hope you will enjoy your tour!

Day 1: Nairobi

You will be met on arrival at Jomo Kenyatta Airport and transferred to the Intercontinental Hotel or the Norfolk for check in. Morning at leisure until lunch time. Afternoon excursion takes you on either a City Tour or to Karen Blixen Museum (not included in price). Return to Hotel for dinner and overnight (dinner not included in price).

Intercontinental Hotel

The popular Intercontinental is an ideal business cum leisure hotel offering high international standards of service and accommodation that are the hallmark of the Intercontinental chain worldwide. Overlooking the city, the Nairobi Uhuru Gardens and the Kenyan Parliament, it is only a 10 minutes walk from the city centre and 20 minutes drive from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. The hotel offers tastefully decorated rooms, good restaurants, conference and meeting rooms, shops, swimming pool, casino and a host of other facilities.

Option B (Norfolk Hotel) Luxury

The **Norfolk Hotel** has welcomed guests to Kenya since 1904 with its high standards of service, luxurious style, hospitality and comfort. The Norfolk Hotel is a thirty-minute drive from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and a short distance from Nairobi's shopping and business district.

The Norfolk has 167 bedrooms, ranging from twin to executive deluxe, luxurious bedrooms, all with private bathrooms, air-conditioning, mini-bar, satellite television, radio and direct dial telephone. The ground floor cottages have a separate lounge and seating area with a writing desk and a patio facing the garden courtyard where you can relax and take in the view.

Four impressive restaurants offer first class cuisine at the Ibis Grill, the Lord Delamere Restaurant, the Delamere Terrace, the Delamere Patio. Enjoy a drink at the Hibiscus Bar & lounge, and the Poolside Restaurant after relaxing all day in the pool or working out in the health club and fully equipped gym. Saunas, steam rooms, aerobics classes and massage facilities are available if you feel like being pampered. There is also a hair and beauty salon.



Day 2: Nairobi

Enjoy breakfast in your Hotel followed by a visit to Windsor Golf Club where you can play golf until lunch time. Enjoy lunch in the Club House followed by afternoon golf. Return to your Hotel for dinner and overnight. **Green fees and Caddy fees included.**

Day 3: Nakuru

Enjoy breakfast at your Hotel and check out. You will be transferred to Sigona Golf Club where you will enjoy a round of golf until lunch time. Have lunch at the Club House. After lunch you will be transferred to Lake Nakuru National Park arriving in the evening with game watching en-route. Dinner and overnight in your Lakeside Lodge. **Green fees and Caddy fees included.**

Situated in the heart of the Rift Valley, Lake Nakuru is one Kenya's most famous soda lakes. A major feature of this park is the birdlife, particularly the thousands of flamingos. A rhino sanctuary also provides the opportunity to see the greatly endangered black rhino. Sarova Lion Hill overlooks the lake, offering a unique vantage point. Each of the 64 superbly appointed chalets has a separate lounge and secluded verandah with views over the lake and the distant hills. They offer a private toilet and shower, mosquito nets and electricity. The lodge restaurant and bar open onto a large viewing deck with panoramic views. The lodge also has a swimming pool, sauna, laundry service, curio and gift shop, game drives in four wheel drive vehicles, conference facilities and a medical clinic. Each night, guests are treated to a performance of traditional dance.

Day 4: Nakuru

Enjoy breakfast and check out, game watching en-route on your drive north east to Mt Kenya Safari Club arriving in time for lunch. Check in and have lunch at the Club House. Afternoon golf at this prestigious Club which is well known for its Golf facilities. Dinner and overnight at Mt Kenya Safari Club. **Includes temporary membership to Club but not caddy fees.**

Mt Kenya Safari Club

Located on the slopes of Mount Kenya, the Mount Kenya Safari Club offers a unique blend of comfort, relaxation and adventure. Set in manicured lawns and decorative ponds and flowerbeds, one can enjoy the surroundings in style against the backdrop of Mount Kenya.

The Club has a total of 144 rooms, consisting of two villas, 13 Riverside and 12 William Holden cottages, eight Garden Suites, Clubrooms and studio suites. All rooms have a private bathroom with shower, telephone and log fireplace. Most rooms also have a private veranda that overlooks Mount Kenya. The luxury villas, William Holden cottages and the presidential suite each have a large sitting room for guests to lounge around in after a round of golf. Guests can also enjoy trout fishing or a game of tennis.

The Mawingo and the Kirinyaga restaurants are readily available, as are two bars, the Zebra Bar and the Trophy Lounge, which have a relaxed and friendly atmosphere. Besides viewing game from a platform there are many more activities and services on offer. There is a heated swimming pool, tennis court, putting green, nine-hole golf course, bowls, croquet, trout fishing, art gallery, health and beauty centre, club shops, game viewing platform and bush dinners are arranged on the banks of the River Likii.

Day 5: Samburu



Breakfast at the Club House and check out followed by morning golf until lunch time. After lunch you drive north to Samburu Game Reserve arriving in the afternoon game watching en-route then directly to your Lodge for check in. Dinner and overnight at your Lodge.

Samburu Serena Lodge

This safari lodge is situated on the fertile banks of the Uaso Nyiro River, in the centre of the Samburu Game Reserve in Kenya's rugged, semi-arid Northern Province. **Samburu Serena Lodge** echoes the robust rhythms of riverfront life and the rustic yet convivial lodge blends well with the environment. All the guest rooms have private verandahs that overlook the river where crocodiles feed in full view. The surrounding terrain is renowned for its rare game. Game drives and bird-watching safaris are the ideal way to experience the native wildlife in its natural splendor. There are 62 rooms, including eight family rooms. Champagne breakfasts overlooking the aptly named Crocodile River are offered, as are moonlit dinners in the bush and beside the pool. A qualified naturalist leads bird-sighting walks on the lodge grounds and slide shows and lectures are given by an expert every evening.

Day 6: Samburu

Full day in this wonderful game reserve with morning and afternoon game drives. Dinner and overnight at Samburu Serena Lodge

Day 7: Nairobi
