



NGORONGORO / SERENGETI TOUR TANZANIA



Ngorongoro/Serengeti tour takes you to the world famous Ngorongoro crater and Serengeti National park. On this particular tour you will get the best wildlife photos on your quest. Pictures of the fantastic migration and wilder beast, together with zebras among many others.

Ngorongoro Conservations Area - The entire Ngorongoro conservations area covers 8300 sq.km. It comprises of several interrelated ecosystems e.g. Crater higlands, vast stretches of plains, woodland and bush. To the west are the alkaline and Masek lakes. These are particularly good areas for the wildlife viewing between December and April, during the rains. In the East are the strings of volcanoe (some are active), Crates and Calderas (collapsed volcanoes). Please note that Ngorongoro Crater itself is about 20 km wide and thus one of the larges Calderas in the world. Lake Magadi, at the crates base hots hundreds of flamingoes. With luck, one might see a black Rhino or two. South of the conversation area is Lake Eyasi. Olduvai Gorge where famous fossils have been excavated, is near the centre of the conservation area.

Serengeti national park is the continuation of the Masai Mara Game Reserve in Kenya. It is Tanzanias's largest and most famous national park covering an area of 14763 sq.km the spectacle of the annual wildlife migrations in the world happens in the two adjoining parks as about one million wilder beasts cross North and South looking for greener pasture. The Serengeti also boast of its lions and cheetahs whereas zebra's number about 200 000. Other animals like giraffes, grant and Thomson's gazelles, impalas, Elads, Warthogs and Klipspringers. The park is also rich with bird life.

Arusha - surrounded by some of Africa's most famous landscapes and national parks. Beautifully situated below Mount Meru on the eastern edge of the eastern branch of the Great Rift Valley, it has a pleasant climate and is close to Serengeti, Ngorongoro Crater, Lake Manyara, Olduvai Gorge, Tarangire National Park and Mount Kilimanjaro, as well as having its own Arusha National Park on Mount Meru. Arusha is the capital of the Arusha Region and has a population of about 300 thousand.



Day 1 – Arusha

You are met on arrival at Kilimanjaro International airport by your tour driver, and are transferred to the New Safari Hotel at the centre of Arusha town. Lunch in your hotel followed by afternoon excursion or shopping. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Accommodation: New Safari Hotel

Day 2 – Lake Manyara

Your day starts by driving from your hotel to Lake Manyara Lodge arriving in time for lunch. The lodge is built on the rim of Lake Manyara therefore giving you the magnificent view to this beautiful salt water lake. At 1600hrs you start your afternoon game drive by driving around the lake, In this National Park you may find the Tree climbing Lions among other cat families. It is also much likely to find the big five in this Park, returning back to your lodge for dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: Lake Manyara lodge

Day 3 – Lake Manyara

Early morning game drive. Perhaps this is the best time for you to see cat families doing their usual activities of hunting for their breakfast. Returning back to your lodge for the late morning breakfast. At 1600hrs afternoon game drive. This time trying to see the animals that you did not see in the morning section, returning back to your lodge for dinner and the overnight.

Accommodation: Lake Manyara Lodge

Day 4 – Ndotu lodge

Departure from the lodge with a drive to Lodwale gate entry to the Ngorongoro conservation. Then proceeding on to Ndotu Lodge arriving in time for lunch. Ndotu lodge is a special place and worth a visit. After dinner you can sit outside by the open round fire and watch as wildlife passes. At 1600hrs you start your game drive in this area, with expectations of the best photo taking.

Accommodation: Ndotu Lodge

Day 5 – Seronera Lodge

Depart and drive down to Seronera Lodge in Serengeti National Park through Nabii Hills gate, arriving in time for lunch. At 1600hrs you start your afternoon game drive in this world famous National Park. The plains of Serengeti National Park go as far as your eyes can see. Do not forget Binoculars for the better view. In this park the safari drivers are not allowed to drive off the road. Returning back to your lodge for the dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: Seronera Lodge

Day 6 – Gibbs farm house

Morning breakfast followed by departure and a drive back through Nabii hills gate and Lodwale gate, arriving at Gibbs farm house in time for lunch. This is a private coffee farm house surrounded by coffee plantations with beautiful landscape. Here you drink fresh farm coffee without beans going to the factory, giving you the true coffee taste.

Accommodation: Gibbs farm House

Day 7 – End of tour

The tour ends by taken you back to Arusha or to Kilimanjaro International airport for your flight.
