Day 1 - Nairobi

On arrival you are met at the airport and transferred to your city Hotel i.e Fairview for check in and breakfast. The rest of the morning will be at leisure till lunchtime and after lunch you may take one of the excursions into Nairobi. You may decide to visit Karen Blixen, or city tour or even visit Nairobi National Park (whereby all these are optional and payments are made direct.) Excursion ends by being driven back in your Hotel.

Day 2 – Treetops

Be ready for joining your safari driver from your city hotel at 9a.m. You will drive north out of Nairobi, past business complexes and into the open country where you will see coffee and sisal plantations. You will also pass by Thika (home to Elspeth Huxley Flames trees Thika Fame) and the Agricultural Research Institute on its rolling Kikuyu agricultural country. You will drive through Nyeri where lunch is taken at the Outspan Hotel. This beautiful hotel was home of the late Lord Baden Powell, founder of the Boy Scout movement (there is also an attractive small museum in his memory.) After lunch, join the hotel’s transport which departs from treetops leaving your large bags in safe storage at the Outspan and taking only your overnight bags. (N. B. Warm clothing is advisable as nights tend to be chilly.) An armed escort will tell you the history of Treetops as he guides you into the tree lodge. Treetops overlook floodlit waterholes visited regularly by buffalo, elephant, warthog, bush pig, a variety of antelope and occasionally lion and other large animals. The evening is spent on the open-air veranda or in the public



areas of the lodge watching animals and birds as they come to drink. . Dinner is served in the panelled dining room. It is possible to arrange a call at night if a particular animal such as the rhino visits the waterhole.

Day 3 – Lion Hill

In the morning, tea and coffee will be served and then you will return to the Outspan for a full English breakfast and possibly views of Mt. Kenya. Join your safari driver and drive around the Aberdare Range of mountains (named after a past president of the National Geographic Society) and down into the Great Rift Valley arriving at Lake Nakuru National Park in time for lunch. Lake Nakuru was created in 1961 originally as an ornithological attraction due to the millions of flamingo's which make the lake their home during certain seasons. The park is approximately 220sq km and during the years with good rain the lake covers a large area. In drier years, the lake does occasionally dry up and huge plumes of dust pervade the nearby township. The park contains a great variety of wildlife as well as innumerable birds. Warthog and waterbuck graze on the lake shore mingling with impala and other antelopes. Nakuru National Park was one of the country's first rhino sanctuaries and rhino can be found browsing on the grassy plains. There are a number of lions; herds of buffaloes and leopard are occasionally seen. Lunch will be in your hotel which is followed by an afternoon game drive in this park. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

Day 4 – Nairobi

Breakfast followed by checkout then a drive back to the capital (Nairobi) arriving in time for lunch, after lunch afternoon shopping down town with an opportunity to visit Africa largest open-air market. The Gikomba Market is just a short drive away and ends by driving you back to your Hotel

Day 5 - Nairobi

Early morning breakfast followed by check out, and a ride to the International Airport for your morning departure flight back home. NB: Check in time is three hours prior to departure time, and this marks the End of the service.
